To Mr. President, Vladimir Putin,

My name is Gheorghe Gavrila Copil, the president of Bucharest-Kishinev Cultural Society and the editor of new electronics magazine, NOI DACII (www.noidacii.ro). I am from Romania, my beloved and so much oppressed homeland, but we will exceed the dramatic situation through which we Romanians live nowadays and will become Romania masters.
